Just as a side note I would like to share a couple of things about Mr. Hughes you may not know. It was seventy-nine years ago this year the Central Square School District became a "Centralized District" and still remains, in terms of land area, one of the largest school districts in New Your State. Along with Paul V. Moore and Aura A. Cole, Mr. Hughes was an integral part of the team and has been referred to as the glue that held the centralization program together. The process began in 1941 and was not completed until 1943. Many of us were a part of the process as the one room schools were closed and we were brought together in Cleveland and Brewerton and finally on the Central Square Campus. Many of us would not be friends and classmates today if it hadn't been for the centralization of our school district.

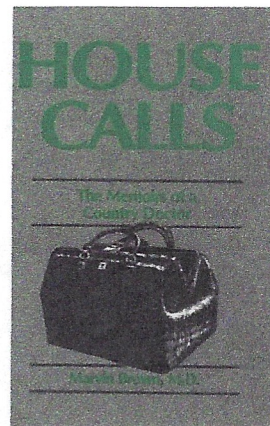
